Dear Parents and Carers,

The following details relate to an educational camp to Birrigai which is being organised for Year 4.

Dates/time: Departing - Monday 26 August at 9.00am
Returning - Wednesday 28 August at 3.00pm

Purpose of excursion: The Birrigai program provides an opportunity for students to engage in a series of challenging yet fun outdoor activities that are designed to provide opportunities for developing self-esteem, team building, peer support and leadership skills through hands on learning in a bush environment. This supports the Year 4 HASS unit of work that the students will be studying and the physical education, health and social emotional learning programs.

Activities: The students will be challenged with a variety of outdoor activities based around leadership and team building, Indigenous perspectives and outdoor adventure. There is a brief description of each activity on the clothing list to help you work out what would be appropriate clothing to bring to camp.
