WELCOME

ENGLISH

Writing: Students will continue with soundwaves spelling, focusing on a different sound each week. Modelled handwriting will take place each week. Students will use their knowledge of persuasive devices to create an advertisement for their HASS project and explore and create a range of information texts.

Speaking & Listening: Students will continue to have opportunities to participate in paired and group work activities with a focus on active listening. They will be given opportunities to present work to their peers.

Reading: Students will continue to revise reading strategies. These include making connections, questioning, summarising and inferring through explicit comprehension activities.

Viewing: A range of texts will be explored and used to practise note taking skills and as writing models for constructing texts.

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MATHEMATICS

Students will continue to revise fundamental number skills and are encouraged to practise their multiplication tables at home to improve their recall. They will pose questions and explore different methods of collecting and representing data to share their findings. Students will explore measurement including length, volume and capacity and temperature. They will conduct chance experiments and describe the variation in results.

HEALTH & PE

Students will continue to focus on good sportsmanship and fair play. In Physical Education lessons they will continue to develop and apply fundamental movement skills and demonstrate movement concepts across a range of class games. Students will focus on their own goal setting and recognising their own strengths and areas for development.

SPECIALIST PROGRAMS

Art: Students will be participating in media arts lessons. They will use digital programs to produce pieces of their own artwork as well as recreating versions of other artworks including Van Gogh's Starry night.

Music: Students will continue to explore and demonstrate musical elements through various activities, utilising diverse platforms and concepts to enhance their musical skills. They will continue to develop their understanding of musical elements and build techniques for effective performance. Additionally, students will explore festive traditions through music.

Physical Education: Students will be learning kicking and catching skills. They will apply fundamental movement skills to correctly kick a ball and perform catching in various situations. Students will be introduced to the steps to correctly perform and perfect these skills. The skills the students learn will be transferrable to other games and sports.

HASS and Science

As a continuation on from the Great Pacific Garbage Patch unit from last term, students will work in groups on an environment project. The project will consist of many different components and will be integrated into other learning areas. Students will identify a problem in our environment, propose a survey question and collect data around this problem, display the data and analyse it, design a solution (product/service/organisation), create an advertisement to sell the product or idea and present their completed projects to their peers.

This project will incorporate learning of the science topics forces and materials. Students will identify forces acting on objects, describing their effect and explore the properties of different materials.
